



The Nordic and Backcountry Skiers Alliance of Idaho was incorporated in 1999 and has been actively involved in protecting and enhancing the quality of nordic and backcountry skiing in the Wood River Valley. We work cooperatively with local and state snowmobile groups and the US Forest Service to resolve any user conflicts that occur in the Valley. The Winter Coalition, a collaboration of skiers and snowmobilers, wrote the landmark 'Snow Pact' agreement in 2000 designating motorized and non-motorized use zones in the north Valley. The Snow Pact is recognized by the Forest Service and incorporated into their winter management plan.
